Micro-credential Program

Pinball**MiCRO** is a fully funded, 15-week micro-credential program developed to upskill marginalized youth with essential employability skills.

Through blended learning, guided mentorship, and real-world applications, the program removes barriers and equips participants to confidently explore career paths.

Pinball**MiCRO** stays engaged after training: the careers team connects graduates with employers, mentors provide ongoing support, and wraparound services remain available to help turn credentials into meaningful employment.

This program is part of the Essential Employability Skills Basics initiative, launched in collaboration with George Brown College to provide accessible, career-relevant micro-credentials to BIPOC and marginalized youth across Canada.
